Phonemic Awareness:

• Identify the beginning sound of words – Mystery Bag

In this tactile activity mothers will place three objects within a bag—like a ball, bug and button for the letter "b"— have your child name each item or help them say the name, and guess the "mystery letter" that is the beginning sound for all the objects.

- Writing practice (a l)
- Use your finger to write in shaving cream.
- Put paint in a plastic bag and let kids write on the bag.
- Make letters out of Lego bricks.

(Do atleast one activity every day)

Math:

• Rote counting to 20

Have your child count as high as they can.

• Counting objects to 10

Use big blocks to build a block tower, or u can use pencils, paper cups/plates to count till 10. Try making different patterns with them. How many blocks?

• Identify numbers 1-20

Use calendar and wall clock to identify numbers

Literacy/Urdu:

• Identify Letters

Identify letters in your environment, in books, or in flashcards. Practice letter sounds. (alif – khay)

• Read a Book or Poem

Read a story with mama. Discuss the sequence, characters and topics. (For moms – discuss illustration and how they relate to the text. Have your child play teacher! Let them ask you questions about the book.)
