POLICY MATTERS



Student ID Cards

Students must wear their ID cards to enter the school. Parents should bring their copy during pick-up and show it to security. No student will be handed over without the collector card.



School Attire

Students must wear the proper uniform, ensuring their hair, jewelry, and nails comply with school policy.



Parents Attire

Parents are asked to dress decently when visiting the school, as they serve as role models for students.



School Leaving Certificate (SLC)

The school may withhold reports, transcripts, and certificates if fees are unpaid. SLC requests after March 1 require payment for the remaining months. Requests before the 5th of the

month require payment for the previous month only; requests after the 5th require payment for the current month. Fees are non-refundable for students leaving mid-term or suspended. SLC processing takes up to 20 working days.



Fee Policy

Fee bills are generated monthly, payable online or at ABL branches. Students with fees unpaid for two months may be removed from the school system. Fees are revised annually per government directives.



Exam Policy

Students taking End-of-Year or Cambridge exams must pay the full academic year's fee from August to July.
